The brag-worthy destination: Transylvania Instagrammable landscapes, delicious wines, off-the-beaten-track

privacy — more and more of the rich and famous are directing their private jets to Transylvania. The luxury hotel site Mr & Mrs Smith has two properties there on its books: the eco-friendly Copsamare Guesthouses and the historic Bethlen Estates (right and below), the latter a stylishly renovated sprawl of 300-year-old residences that will be opening luxury barn accommodation in March. Expect elevated spins on traditional local fare while you're staying there, such as wild river trout tartare. Prince Charles owns several properties in the region, including in the village of Malancrav, and the half-Romanian Emma Raducanu recently played in the Transylvania Open. The country is a bit of a tennis hotspot, in fact: Romania has eight players in the women's top 150, double that of the UK. Make sure to visit the charming Transylvanian Saxon village of Biertan, a Unesco world heritage site, and of course take a trip to Bran Castle — yes, Dracula's castle — which even has its own restaurant.
